

Associate of Applied Science in Business to Bachelor of Arts in Business and Applied Science

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Black Hawk College (BHC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Interdisciplinary Studies degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree in Business from BHC and a Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree in Business and Applied Science from GSU. All programs in GSU's College of Business are accredited by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB), the hallmark of excellence in business education.
